

This statement refers to when I was a victim of common assault, violence to secure entry and attempted criminal damage.

On Sunday 31st AUGUST 2025 I was at my home address of 60 HUNSDON ROAD, SE14 with my partner Emily Scorer. Between the hours of 1130-1330 Emily was getting ready to leave the home address and before she left, she asked me if I had any plans for lunch to which I did not. I did not think much of this until approximately 1430hours when I there was a TESCO WHOOSH delivery driver at my door who handed me a bag of food but did not say anything to me prior to leaving. Due to Emily asking me if I had plans for lunch, I believed that she had ordered me food because she had previously used WHOOSH. After the delivery driver left, I closed the door and looked inside the bag and found desserts. At this point I questioned if Emily had ordered this food as it was not a meal and decided to text Emily to ask her if this was a delivery meant for me. Emily did not reply, and I continued to question who this delivery belongs to, so I tried to call TESCOS. When I called TESCOS the phone call kept going to an automated answer machine. Approximately 5 minutes after receiving the delivery I heard someone knocking on my door, this knocking sounded loud and aggressive. Prior to opening the door, I made sure I had the delivery bag with me because I thought it would either be the delivery driver or potentially the owner of the dessert.

I opened the door and saw a man I know to live on my road. I would describe this man as light skinned black male who is bald, approximately 6ft with a thin/athletic build. This male also looked roughly 35/40 years old, and I will refer to him as MALE throughout this statement. Once I had opened the door, I asked the male if the order was his and went to hand him the bag. The male has then grabbed the bag and started to become verbally aggressive calling me a thief and shouting. The male has then pushed me in the chest causing me to move backwards and the male has then tried to barge into my property. I have then managed to regain my balance and tried to close the front door. However, the male put his foot in the doorway preventing me from closing it. As I have struggled to keep this man out of my property, I have looked around to see if anyone could help me. I looked across the street and saw someone stood there so I shouted out for them to call the police, but I do not think that they did call the police. At this point I was still struggling to keep the male out and was becoming fearful for my safety I let go of the door and run upstairs to grab my phone to


call the police myself. I could not call the police as I could not find my phone in the panic, so I pressed the SOS button on my home alarm and ran back downstairs. When I got back downstairs, I saw this male stood in inside my property and I have then shouted at him to leave. The male ignored my request, so I tried to push him out. The male has then become further physically aggressive towards me and started to strike me by punching in the head, face and chest multiple times with both hands however in one hand he had the delivery, so this possibly softened the blow. After struggling with this male, I managed to get him out of my property and shut the door.

When the male was outside, he started to kick my front door for several minutes and kept moving himself backwards to be able to use more force to kick the door. Whilst kicking the door I could also hear him shouting that I am thief and that I was calling the police. During this time, I was able to find my phone and call the police who arrived shortly after who spoke to the male and myself separately. After police left, I looked at my front door and had noticed that there were small marks of damage on my door however I do not have an image of the damage.

Approximately 5 hours after police left the male approached my property again and left a note using the same WHOOSH bag stating "MI5 LOVE" above the WHOOSH writing.
